Trip Overview

Expected Itinerary (Day-by-Day)

Day 1–2: Departure & Nairobi

- *Depart Detroit for Nairobi (via Amsterdam or other hub).*
- *Overnight in Nairobi; welcome dinner.*

Day 3: Nairobi → Lake Nakuru

- *Drive through the Rift Valley to flamingo-rich Lake Nakuru.*
- *Afternoon game drive; stay near the lake.*

Day 4–6: Lake Nakuru → Masai Mara Reserve

- *Travel across Rift Valley to Masai Mara.*
- *Two full days of game drives, optional Maasai village visit, possible balloon safari.*

Day 7: Border Crossing → Serengeti (Tanzania)

- *Cross at Isebania; enter Serengeti National Park.*
- *Afternoon game drive en route to central Serengeti lodge or camp.*

Days 8–10: Serengeti

- *Two full days of game drives exploring different sectors of the Serengeti plains.*

Day 11–12: Serengeti → Ngorongoro Crater

- *Drive to Ngorongoro Highlands; descend into the crater for wildlife viewing.*
- *Overnight on crater rim.*

Day 13: Ngorongoro → Tarangire

- Morning crater drive; then drive on to Tarangire National Park.
- Afternoon game drive among ancient baobab trees.

Day 14–16: Tarangire → Arusha

- Morning in Tarangire, then transfer to Arusha for cultural visit or leisure day.
- Final group dinner in Arusha.

Day 17–18: Return Journey

- Fly from Arusha to Nairobi and onward to international departure.
- Arrive back in the U.S. (DTW) on Day 19.

- Accommodations in lodges and tented camps along the safari route
- Full board on safari days; breakfast included in Nairobi and Arusha
