## Sample Itinerary (Day-by-Day)

**Direction: Bucharest to Budapest** (*Itinerary may operate in reverse*)

### **Day 1 (Sep 6): Depart the U.S.**

- Board your overnight international flight from Detroit (or selected gateway).

### **Day 2: Arrive in Bucharest, Romania**

- Transfer to your hotel for a one-night stay.
- Evening welcome dinner and group introductions.

### **Day 3: Explore Bucharest • Embark Ship**

- Tour Bucharest: Revolution Square, Palace of the Parliament, and historic Lipscani district.
- Transfer to Giurgiu to board your river cruise ship.
- Settle in and enjoy a welcome toast onboard.

### **Day 4: Cruise the Danube → Ruse, Bulgaria**

- Cruise into Bulgaria.
- Dock in **Ruse**, known for its Austro-Hungarian architecture.
- Optional walking tour or free time in the town center.

### **Day 5: Veliko Tarnovo & Arbanassi (Bulgaria)**

- Full-day excursion to **Veliko Tarnovo**, medieval capital of the Second Bulgarian Empire.
- Explore nearby **Arbanassi**, a hilltop village of stone houses and 17th-century churches.

### **Day 6: Vidin & Baba Vida Fortress**

- Tour the preserved **Baba Vida Fortress** overlooking the Danube.
- Optional visit to Belogradchik rock formations or local winery.

### **Day 7: Iron Gates Gorge & Serbia**

- Cruise through the **Iron Gates Gorge**, the most dramatic section of the lower Danube.
- Enter Serbia, arriving in **Donji Milanovac**.

### **Day 8: Belgrade, Serbia**

- Guided tour of Serbia's capital, Belgrade: Kalemegdan Fortress, Republic Square, and Saint Sava Cathedral.
- Optional evening folk performance or dinner ashore.

### **Day 9: Novi Sad & Vukovar**

- Visit **Novi Sad**, with its riverside promenade and Petrovaradin Fortress.
- Continue to **Vukovar**, Croatia—learn about its role in the 1990s conflict and ongoing revival.

### **Day 10: Osijek, Croatia**

- Walking tour of **Osijek**—baroque Old Town, open-air markets, and peaceful promenades.
- Optional home-hosted lunch with local families.

### **Day 11: Mohács & Pécs, Hungary**

- Dock in **Mohács**, gateway to the wine region of Pécs.
- Explore Roman ruins, a 4th-century Christian necropolis, and vibrant local markets.

### **Day 12: Budapest, Hungary**

- Arrive in **Budapest** and enjoy a guided tour of Buda Castle, Matthias Church, and Heroes' Square.
- Optional nighttime illumination cruise.

### **Day 13: Free Day in Budapest**

- Leisure time to visit the thermal baths, shop local markets, or join optional excursions.
- Farewell dinner and celebration onboard.

### **Day 14 (Sep 19): Disembark & Return Home**

- *Transfer to the airport for your flight back to the U.S.*
- *Arrive home same day with unforgettable memories of the Danube.*



## What's Included

- 11-night river cruise on a comfortable 4-deck ship
- 1 hotel night in Bucharest or Budapest (depending on direction)
- Daily guided cultural excursions
- All onboard meals with regional wines and beer

## Additional Notes

- **Activity Level:** Moderate – must walk 2–3 miles/day over uneven surfaces
